



Dear Patient:

### What to do before you arrive

Prior to the day of your procedure our anesthesia provider will contact you to obtain your medical history. Your arrival time will be given to you two business days before your procedure.

Your preparation at home before your procedure is a very important part of the success of your procedure. Carefully read and follow your physician's instructions. Remember, preparation can start as much as 24-36 hours before your appointment, so make sure you read these instructions a couple of days ahead of time in order to be prepared.

- **Please contact your doctor's office if you have any questions about your prep instructions.**
- **Leave jewelry and valuables at home.**

Wear comfortable, loose clothing that is easy to take off and put back on.

### Please bring the following with you when you come in for your procedure:

1. Your insurance card(s)
2. A valid drivers license or other form of identification
3. A list of medications you are currently taking.
4. Your co-pay if applicable
5. You may not drive following your procedure, so please arrange for a driver. A taxi or Uber is not adequate unless you are accompanied by a friend or relative 18 years of age or older who will take responsibility for you.

### Insurance and Payment

#### IMPORTANT Information regarding payment of your scheduled procedure:

The Endo Center at Voorhees accepts most major insurances. We will bill your insurance accordingly; however, it is our policy to require payment of any co-pays, co-insurance and deductibles prior to your procedure. You may receive a patient estimate\* prior to your procedure via text message, email or mail.

You will be provided a link or web address to make your payment. You will be provided with many payment options.

You may also receive bills for the physician's professional fee, anesthesia services and pathology if biopsies are taken.

## Directions

### **From the North (Route 70 and 73 Marlton Circle)**

Take Route 73 South 5 miles to Cooper Road. Turn right onto Cooper Road and a left at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Driveway.

### **From the South (Berlin Circle)**

Take Route 73 North 1.5 miles to Cooper Road. Turn left onto Cooper, and a left at the 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway.

### **From the West (Evesham and Cooper Road)**

Take Cooper Road South 3 miles. Turn Right at 93 Cooper Road

### **From the East (Evesham Road and Route 73)**

Take Route 73 South 5 miles to Cooper Road. Turn right onto Cooper Road and a left at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Driveway.
